day 1.

Roadtrip

Your adventure begins very early in Cusco city, where we will depart at 5:00 am from your hotel or one of the *pick-up points*.

In comfortable private transportation, you will cross the Sacred Valley along an amazing route from the Andes to the Jungle, stopping to photograph impressive landscapes.

Half-day at Wayqecha

You will have a relaxing breakfast at Wayqecha Bio-Station, enjoying amazing views of the ecological gradient in a cloud forest. You will be able to experience a 40 meters-high canopy walkway and the Andean Bear research center.

Arriving Manu Bio Lodge

After an exciting journey, you will discover your cabin in front of a lagoon home of many birds.

After a nutritious lunch, you will walk or bike around the various trails and gardens.

Along with your dinner you will have an inspiring conservation talk led by the team in charge of the projects carried out at the field station.

Sensory Awakening

You will enjoy the sunrise from your cabin, accompanied by the song of countless birds. The **ForestWhisper**® experience or practicing yoga are great options to start the day.

The Golondrina Expedition

After breakfast we will set off on an exciting expedition into a pristine forest home to large mammals in search of the Golondrina Waterfall.

Whether you accept the challenge of walking for 03 hours through these forests, or go by boat along the Piñi-Piñi River, you will cross the main research trails of the biological station team, just to explore these magical forest with the **EcoDroneView**® experience.

This activity has an extra cost of USD 80 per person for the use of boat transportation.

This is a guided activity, so if you decide to stay and enjoy the lodge's amenities, just let your guide know.




Our main facilities are located just a few minutes from Pilcopata, in our restored forest;

designed so that you can connect with the nature of this incredible place. Our commitment is that you have a comfortable and safe experience, so that you can live an immersion in the Amazon.





• is it for me?

We believe that nature is for everyone. Whether you're a seasoned adventurer or new to eco-travel, our experiences are designed to be inclusive and enriching for all. However, it's important to note that our journeys do take you off the beaten path. You'll encounter the vibrant, untamed beauty of the rainforest—this means you might meet some of its wild inhabitants, experience varying weather conditions, and navigate natural terrain. If you're ready to embrace nature in all its forms, Ecotone is the perfect place to begin or continue your adventure.

• when do I need to arrived to Cusco?

We recommend arriving in Cusco at least one day before your departure. While Manu Bio Lodge itself is situated below 500 meters above sea level, so acclimatization isn't necessary for the destination, it's important to note that the journey to Manu includes driving through paths at elevations above 4,000 meters. Arriving a day early gives you time to prepare and adjust before embarking on the road trip.

Briefing meeting

The night before departure, we will hold an online briefing meeting to provide detailed information about the upcoming trip. This is an excellent opportunity to go over the itinerary, ask any final questions, and ensure you're fully prepared for our incredible immersive experience.

Pick-up and drop off points

Our pick-up and drop-off point is the Plaza Mayor in Cusco. If requested at least 3 days before departure, we can also arrange pick-up from accommodations within a 5-minute drive of the plaza. Departure is at 5:00 a.m., and we ask that everyone be ready 30-45 minutes beforehand to ensure a smooth start to the day.

• Can I store my luggage at your office?

Yes! We need to arrange this with time, by email or at the briefing meeting. Keep in mind that your hotel might offer this service as well.

• Additional help or assistance?

Our team is ready to help you with whatever you need. Even if it is not within our control, we will be happy to connect you with additional assistance during your trip to Cusco/Peru.

you should bring.

luggage

You'll need to have a backpack. No wheels luggage (carry-on or similars) are allow.

We recommend **not exceeding 10 kilos** of luggage per person, and consider the following elements:

- Passport
- · Personal medication
- Photographic camera
- · Long pants of light fabric and light colours
- Long-sleeved shirts or t-shirts, made of light fabric and light colours
- Battery-powered head torch (flashlights)
- Sunglasses
- Cap
- Sunscreen
- Rain poncho or waterproof jacket
- Warm clothing for the road trip and cold nights (depending the season)
- Insect repellent (optional)
- Pocket money
- Small backpack for daily excursions
- · Bathing suit and towel
- Light shoes for in-doors areas
- Trekking socks (light fabric easy to dry)
- Lots of energy
- Hunger for learning and experiencing new adventures
